We have the pleasure to give you further information on the 2021 Borilli FIM EnduroGP World Championship Season.

However, the calendar will still be conditioned by the evolution of the pandemic and any possible government and authorities' decisions. FIM will not be responsible for any changes and preventive measure that could be announced any time.

**The FIM Women's Enduro World Cup is becoming a World Championship with 3 rounds to count for the Final classification (Portugal, Sweden and France).

ENTRIES - OPENING ON MAY 11TH

PROCEDURE FOR NEW ENTRIES

1. Go to: www.endurogp-registration.com
2. Create your account
3. Your account will be validated manually
4. Select the rounds you wish to enter
5. Once you pay for your entry, you will receive automatic confirmation.



DEADLINES FOR ENTRIES

- Entries should be made 21 days before each event.
- For the entries made between 21 and 2 days before the administrative control of the Event, a fine of 50€ (30 € for Enduro Open) will apply.
- Two days before the Event no entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES

- 320 EUR for Male Rider.
- 250 EUR for Women & Youth Rider.
- 120 EUR for the Enduro Open Class.
- The renting fees of the transponders are included in the entry fee.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Any cancellation certified by the rider's FMN, under presentation of a medical certificate, will be reimbursed (with a reduction of 30 € as an administration fee) by the FIM within 15 days after the event if the cancellation is confirmed within three days of the preliminary inspections.
- Riders cancelling their entries for any other reason will not be reimbursed.

CHANGE OF CATEGORY

During the Series, if a rider has already obtained points, he will be allowed to move to another category, but will not be allowed to score any Championship points in this new category.

Each Rider must contact its National Federation to obtain the correct FIM Enduro World Championships and Prizes Licence according to the planned participation (please note that CONU Championships licences will not be valid).

ENDURO TEAM LICENCE

This licence shall be associated to at least 1 Rider and it entitles the team to having their name in the official results. Requests need to be addressed to licences@fim.ch before **30/05/2021** (each Rider can only be assigned to 1 Team).

MANUFACTURERS LICENCE

Requests need to be addressed to licences@fim.ch before **30/05/2021**.
